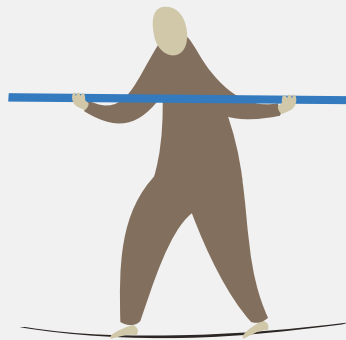

Prof. Michael Halmagyi has made a revolution in the vestibular field.

The creator of the VHIT - a simple and comfortable test which changed everyday vestibular practice to become easier and more informative. After 30 years of implementation of this test prof. Halmagyi will share the accumulated knowledge, clinical application and results interpretation in various vestibular abnormalities. Also, we are keen to hear the controversies about discrepancy between VHIT and caloric test results, speculations about compensatory saccades generator place and reduced/augmented VOR gain in central vestibular disorders.
